SUMMER EMPLOYMENT - INTERPRETIVE GUIDES

WanuskeWIN Heritage Park is accepting applications for 4 Full Time Interpretive Guides for the summer reporting to the Visitor Services Manager. The position will include the following duties:

- * Greets and welcomes visitors with an orientation to the Park, including current and upcoming activities
- * Advises visitors of the location of services such as Exhibits, Gallery, Dance Performances, Trail System, Archaeology Sites, Gift Shop, Restaurant, and Washrooms
- * Introduce and explain interpretive displays, conduct flora and fauna tours, and provide information and conduct demonstrations on a variety of traditional lifestyle activities
- * Presenting workshops on traditional crafts, and monitor the condition of park trails, exhibits and visitor areas, to ensure the public's safety and that all interactive exhibits are operational
- * Conducts various building and program tours (trail walks) and demonstrations providing interpretation of Plain Indian Culture, natural history and ecological features, exhibits, displays and artifacts
- * Will be required to stay overnight for Tipi Sleepovers
- * May be required to Pow Wow dance and/or sing periodically
- * Available to work weekends and evenings as required
- * Work special events as required

Qualifications:

- * Must be returning to a post-secondary institution in the Fall
- * Must be able to provide own transportation to and from work
- * Strong interpersonal skills and comfortable with public speaking
- * Knowledge of First Nations culture and traditions
- * Pow Wow Dancers and/or Singers will be given preference
- * Enjoy working with children
- * Knowledge of a POS Operating System is an asset
- * CPIC required
- * Must be bondable
